

NATIONALLY RECOGNISED COMPETENCY RIIOHS202A—Enter and Work in Confined Spaces

OVERVIEW

This course will enable participants to recognise a confined space according to BHP Billiton Iron Ore Confined Space Procedure MAN-IHS-SAF-005. This course is designed for any person(s) required to enter and work in a confined space on a BHPBIO Site and/or any person(s) required to work as a standby/entry for confined spaces on a BHPBIO Site.

This course comprises an equal theory-practical component ensuring all participants actively participate in confined space entries.

KEY OUTCOMES

DEFINITIONS:

- Have an understanding of equipment safety requirements.
- Be able to correctly apply confined space entry and exit procedures.
- Have the ability to explain the risks and hazards experienced in confined spaces.
- Have an understanding of air contamination and common toxic gases.
- Recognise breathing apparatus, respirators and their limitations.
- Be able to apply isolations and controls.
- Be able to use basic atmospheric monitoring devices.
- Be able to correctly complete risk assessments, complete permits and follow workplace procedures for confined space working.
