Overview

This course provides participants with the skills and knowledge of the equipment and techniques to perform tower rescue within the working environment.

The practical aspects of the course cover basic access techniques and basic rescue of a single person and operator.

PRE-REQUISITES

1. A Work Safely at Heights Certificate (MNMG237A—Work Safely at Heights); **AND**
2. A current Senior First Aid Certificate or equivalent (PUAEME001B—Provide Emergency Care or HLTA1A—Apply Basic First Aid). Participants who do not possess this qualification will receive a “Statement of Participation” which can be upgraded at a later date if a First Aid Certificate is obtained.
